PACKING LIST

WHAT TO BRING:

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

electronic devices -We ask NO PHONES. They interfere with the camp experience and aren't needed up at camp. While we understand that for most kids, their phone is also their camera, we cannot be responsible for phones that get lost/damaged/stolen up at camp. Best to leave them at home, and send a disposable camera. We will have a videographer/photographer up at camp who will take lots of footage and photos.
