- Serve as a spiritual leader to the worship team and congregation, providing guidance, encouragement, and pastoral care.

 - **3.** Please share how you integrate spiritual formation into your own life and the life of the worship team. For example, what spiritual disciplines and practices have been formative for you?
 - **4.** Please provide a theology of ethnicity and culture that guides your worship ministry.
- 2. Initial Chat: We'll set up an initial meeting to get to know you better, via Zoom if you are not local.
- 3. Interviews: Meet with several members of our pastoral and church staff, along with worship team members to dive deeper into your vision and leadership style and also for you to get to know us better
- **4. Onsite Visit:** You may be invited to join us in person to experience our community firsthand and meet the team in person.
- **5. Decision:** We aim to make a final decision before the holidays and possibly have the start date scheduled for the first few months of 2025.
